



## Feasibility Studies

### The Issue

The whole process of site closure as defined in the Closure Management Overview can be very complex. To enable an objective analysis, a feasibility study is required to select the site or sites that warrant closure. This feasibility study ideally should consider a wide range of factors including site fixed costs, supply chain costs, capital requirements and personnel costs. Most importantly it should contain the site(s) liabilities and potential asset or disposal value.

### The Objective

To ensure that the correct strategic closure decisions are made and that the data used in the Feasibility Study is up to date and accurate.
